

Video Transcript

- Welcome, we are so excited about having students back on campus. We have missed you so much.
- We have been busy on campus attending to the health and safety of our students. We have set up sanitation stations with hand gel sanitizer, added additional hand washing stations, and have purchased sanitizing equipment to sanitize the playground and classrooms after use. We have done our part, now we need you to do yours.
- In order to be safe and continue to stay open, we have been given county and state guidelines that must be followed.
 - **Morning drop off:** Per the state guidelines we are to limit the amount of parents on campus. Instead of parking and walking children to the classrooms, children must be dropped off in designated areas of the school parking lot or at the Sutter Road walk in gate. Please do not drop students off on the sidewalk on Fremont. The walk in gate is locked for traffic flow and we do not want students running through the parking lot through moving cars.
 - **Students must have a mask on when attending school.** We are requiring that you leave a couple of masks in your child's desk in a ziplock bag. Students without a mask will be given one from the front office and your FACTS account will be charged for it. Temperatures will be taken daily in the classroom by a touchless thermometer. Those students with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be asked to go home. Please do not bring sick children to school, it puts us all at risk. We will be emailing a soft survey that we ask you to fill out for your child to ensure they have not had contact with anyone that has been diagnosed with COVID. Any changes to your answers should be updated as needed as well as notifying the school office. If your child does get sick at school, we ask that you please make arrangements with a family member or friend to pick up your child as soon as possible.
 - **Staying in cohorts including recess and lunch:** While at school students will be with only their classmates throughout the day including recess. They will not be playing with students from other classes which will allow us to limit transmission of colds, flu and COVID. Please send a lunch and snack daily with your child. We are not able to provide a lunch program at this time. Due to lunch being eaten in the classrooms, we are asking that students only bring water as a drink with their snack and lunch. Students should bring a refillable water bottle with them to school and may refill them at the filtered fountains. When spilt, milk becomes sour in the carpets. Also, juices when spilt stain carpets and attract ants.
 - **Afternoon Pick up procedures:** In the afternoon, students in grades Kindergarten through 4th grades will be lined up outside of their classrooms. We have created a name plate with your child's name on it to be placed in your passenger window. When the teachers see your car arrive, your child will be sent to the pick up cones to wait for you to drive up to the cone before entering

your car. We will have students line up in the order the cars arrive to make pick up as seamless as possible. Students in 5th and 6th grades will line up for pick up at the Sutter Road walk in gate and the same procedure will apply. If you have children in both groups, the oldest child will go to the youngest child's classroom to wait for pick up.

- **Extended Care:** We are not able to offer extended care at this time and all students must be picked up at the end of the school day. If you will be picking up a student for another family, please make a copy of their name plate so that we can send that child to the correct car.
- Other items that you need to know:
 - Student supply lists may be found on the front page of our website. Supplies can be dropped off prior to Wednesday if you would like. You may also stop by and peek into your child's classroom and see how we are set up for their return.
 - Students will not be taking computers back and forth from school. Any checked out equipment including headphones need to come back to school when the student returns. Please leave personal computers at home. Cell phones that are brought to school will be collected daily and returned at the end of the day.
 - We are giving a 30 day grace period on school uniforms. This is not a free dress pass. If uniforms have not been ordered or have not arrived, students need to be in navy docker type pants or shorts and a red or white collared shirt. By starting on Wednesday, everyone has plenty of time for haircuts and hair styles to be in compliance with our school handbook.
 - SCRIP is still being sold in the library. We ask that you call in the morning with your order and we can have it available for you at the end of the day. Please call the school office to place your orders.
 - We have a PTG meeting scheduled for this Thursday at 6:30 pm. It will be held on the grass by the gym. It will also be available virtually if you are not able to attend. Please bring a chair to sit in and it would be best to leave children at home, we will not have supervision and the playground will not be available to them.

I know that this is a lot of information. Hopefully this video has alleviated some of your concerns and will help with a smooth transition back to school. Prior to coming back, there is one more item that needs to be completed - you have been emailed a Risk of Liability Agreement form to be filled out prior to your child returning to the classroom.
